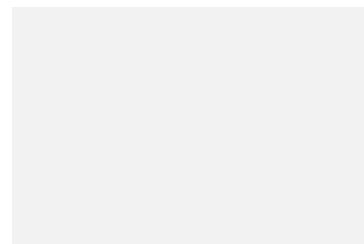

His influence can be seen in the achievements of numerous Public Sector Shingo Prize recipients such as Warner Robins Air Logistics Center, Red River Army Depot, Rock Island Arsenal, and the Port Hueneme Division of Naval Surface Warfare Centers.

He has worked with over 100 organizations on four continents including Lockheed Martin, General Dynamics, Northrop Grumman, Rockwell Collins, Sikorsky, Cobalt Boats, The NORDAM Group, U.K. Royal Air Force, State of Kansas, Caterpillar, BAE, GE, Pratt and Whitney, and the Saudi Arabian Oil Company.
